This event is not just for speedy folks. Come out and bring your family for the fun walk and the kids races. Kids races include 100 meter, 400 meter, and 1 mile run.



Nature Trail News

Exciting news! The dam history Kiosk was installed yesterday on the hiking trail below the dam. It gives a brief history of Dutch Hollow Lake and the construction of the dam.

Take a fall hike and take a look at the beautiful kiosk designed and installed by Henke Signs.



Fall is a fabulous hiking opportunity. Keep your eyes peeled for some of nature's beauty along the hiking trail. Some of my favorites are there right now.

Indian Pipe or Ghost Plant is a member of the blueberry family. It is entirely white (lacks chlorophyll), the leaves are scale-like appendages, some may be pink – salmon color, it has a single stem and flower at the end of the stem. The pipes grow in shady woods, directly on the ground, within rotting leaves. The ghosts appear and bloom roughly June – September.



Black Eyed Susan are a hallmark along the prairies and meadows of the hiking trail. All have daisy-like flowers with sultry dark 'eyes' and brightly-colored petals which emanate pure joy.



Milkweed plants are the sole source of food for monarch caterpillars and the place monarch butterflies go to lay their eggs. So as more and more milkweed has disappeared from the environment over the last several decades, the loss of milkweed has endangered the monarch butterfly population. Fortunately, it's super-easy to help the situation by planting a milkweed patch.

Boating Safety Reminders

Boating

All motorized boats and all non-motorized boats twelve feet long or longer (sailboats, canoes, etc.) must be registered with the Department of Natural Resources. Federal law requires that a boat be registered "in the State of major use". Wisconsin describes the State of major use as the one where a boat is used or kept available for use more than 60 consecutive days.

Current additional Township ordinances that govern the use of boats on Dutch Hollow Lake include specific water ski hours, and a "slow-no-wake" requirement from sunset to sunrise.

The State requires that boats must be operated at "slow-no-wake" speeds within 100 feet of shore, piers, docks, swimming zones marked by swim buoys and in bay areas marked by "slow-no-wake" buoys. "Slow-no-wake" speed is defined as operation at the slowest speed that the boat can be operated and still maintain steering control. Boats must not enter into swimming areas marked by swim buoys.

The newest boating ordinance is for watercraft in "displacement mode":

No one shall operate a boat in displacement mode for 1000 feet or more within 200 feet of shore.

Displacement mode means any watercraft that is creating a large wake while in motion in a slow speed with the bow up.

Anyone noticing any **boating violations** please report to Sauk Co. Sheriff's Department (which includes the Town of LaValle Police) 608-356-4895 or the Wisconsin Department of Resources 1-800-TIP-WDNR. Pictures/videos are always helpful to them.

Always obtain and review a *current* copy of Wisconsin boating laws, as these are updated annually.

Water Skiing

Water skiing is permitted on Dutch Hollow Lake between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. It is forbidden between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. A boat towing a water skier must have both an operator facing forward and a "spotter" facing the skier.



Water skiers must wear an approved personal flotation device.

Boats towing skiers must maintain a distance of 100 feet from any occupied anchored boat, any personal watercraft, or marked swimming area or public boat landing.

Personal Watercraft

Current Wisconsin boating laws differ for personal watercraft and other watercraft.

Personal watercraft are restricted to slow-no-wake speed within 200 feet of the shoreline of any lake.


Most of Dutch Hollow Lake is less than 400 feet wide. So, the only area a personal watercraft can be operated at speeds greater than slow-no-wake is on the widest part of the main body of the lake. Slow-no-wake is defined as operation at the slowest speed that the boat can be operated and still maintain steering control.

100' is the minimum distance for operating a personal watercraft from boats, skiers, other personal watercraft, swim areas docks or boat landings.

Swimming

State of Wisconsin ordinances govern swimming in Wisconsin lakes.

- No person shall swim from any unmanned boat unless such boat is anchored.
- No person shall swim more than 100 feet from the shore unless in a designated swimming zone or when accompanied by a competent person in a boat.
- No person shall swim more than 100 feet from the shoreline between sunset and sunrise.

For 2024 reservation requests: written applications will be accepted until **September 8, 2023**. On September 9, 2023 at the regular monthly Board of Directors meeting, the Board will draw the applications on a lottery basis.

All applications must be submitted on the following form and must be received at the Association office no later than 9/8/23. With these lottery applications you will be considered for a **one-week rental per member**.

In the event that not all the available weeks are requested by the lottery applications, phone reservations will be taken beginning September 11, 2023 for the remaining weeks.

The weekly rental period will be Sunday to Sunday. The summer season begins Sunday, May 26, 2024, and continues thru Sunday, September 1, 2024. (Before and after the above peak rental period it may be reserved for a two night minimum stay if desired.)

All applicants will be notified by mail of the results of the lottery. Deposits will be required 30 days after your reservation is made, and reservation will be canceled if deposit is not received by deadline specified.

2024 Seasonal Camping



There will be 17 seasonal campsites available in 2024.

You may apply only for the sites listed on the application form. Please indicate your first, second, and third choice. If your name is drawn, every effort will be made to assign a site you prefer. However, there is no guarantee that you will get any site, or that you will get a site listed as your preference. This is a lottery. **Only one application per lot owned please.** Friends or relatives that own lots cannot apply on your behalf.

If there are more applicants than there are sites available, the additional applicants will be placed on a waiting list in the order drawn, and will be offered the sites in the event of cancellations. **The lottery drawing will be held at the Board of Directors meeting on September 9, 2023.** If you would like to be present at the drawing, you are welcome.

You may phone the Association office on Monday, September 11, 2023 to find out the results of the drawing. If there are 17 or fewer applicants, the drawing will determine site assignments only, because all applicants will get sites. We will not take phone calls during the drawing.

You will be notified of the results by mail, and must pay a \$500 deposit by October 2, 2023, with the balance due March 2024.

If you get a seasonal site, you will be required to sign an agreement regarding your responsibilities. Responsibilities include a personal mowing requirement for your assigned site. Do not apply for a seasonal site if you cannot fulfill the mowing requirement.

Your Association dues for 2024 must be paid in full for all lots owned to be eligible for seasonal camping. If dues are not paid by the date of the March 2024 final billing, your site assignment will be canceled.

Clip and return the application so that it reaches the Association office by 3 p.m. on September 8, 2023. Sorry, we cannot be responsible for lost or misdirected mail. Please mail early.
